



Grand Final Most Valuable Player Process

What is the Grand Final Most Valuable Player Award?

The Grand Final MVP is awarded to the player who is identified as having made the most significant contribution in the game and receives the highest number of votes based on the selection criteria.

What criteria are used to determine the Grand Final Most Valuable Player?

- Has the most impact during the game;
- Displays leadership, courage & fairness;
- Shows good sportsmanship;
- Respects the Referees & opposition; and
- Supports team mates to contribute.

How is the Award determined?

The two assigned Referees or (combination Referee / Referee Supervisor) and an appointed HRBA Official will award points to the players participating in each Grand Final of the summer & winter competitions.

Each Referee & Official will award votes as follows on the voting slip, noting player number & club / team name:

| • MVP | 3 points |
| • 1 st Runner-up | 2 points |
| • 2 nd Runner-up | 1 point |

The two players with the most votes will be awarded the MVP and Runner-up for each Grand Final. In the event of a tied vote, both players will be awarded the MVP and no Runner-up will be selected.

Awards will be presented on overall votes independently, regardless of the players' team. If the two highest vote scorers are from the same team, the awards will be presented as such.

Records will be retained and filed with the Season Awards master sheet.
